### Boat Brigade Roles

- Note-taker
- Photographer (and/or videographer) and GPS coordinate logger

### Observation Guidelines

- Take photos and video whenever possible.
- Describe the exact location (most phones and cameras embed GPS coordinates in photos)

### Conditions to Note

- Water conditions (turbid/clear; current fast/slow; land use on banks)
- Unusual conditions (discoloration; odors; signs of dead wildlife; evidence of dumping; erosion)
- Outfalls (SPDES, MS4 and other pipe, culvert and ditch outfalls)
